User Guide

Advanced Custom Links module provides features to manage top menu and customer account sidebar. It provides flexibility to store owners to manage these links from the admin panel without doing changes at code level.

A new link can be added in the top menu before/after/inside any of the existing menu. You can also manage the category to be used as the parent category to show its child categories in the top menu. Custom links can be added to the customer my account sidebar and the existing link in it can be repositioned. So this module makes it easy to manage the link of the top menu and customer sidebar.

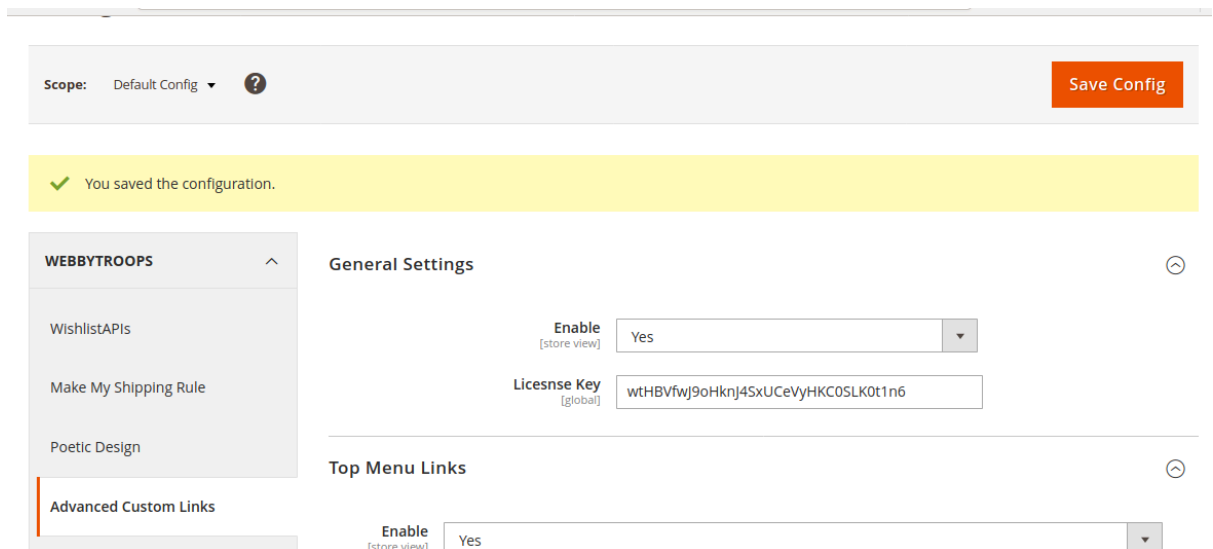

1. Introduction and Purpose

Purpose of this module is to make it easy to manage the links of the top menu and customer my account sidebar. Users can add new links and change the root category for the top menu from the backend. New links can be added as wekk. Label and position of existing links can be changed in the customer my account sidebar.

2. How to enable extension?

Once you get the license key (refer to installation guide) you need to navigate to the Advance Custom Links section under **Stores > Configuration > WebbyTroops**. Once you have added the valid key you will be able to enable this extension. Below is the screenshot where you need to add that license key.



3. Add new link to Top Menu

You can add a new link to the Top Menu after or before any existing category in the menu. Links can also be added before or after sub-categories shown under any category in the menu as shown in the image below.

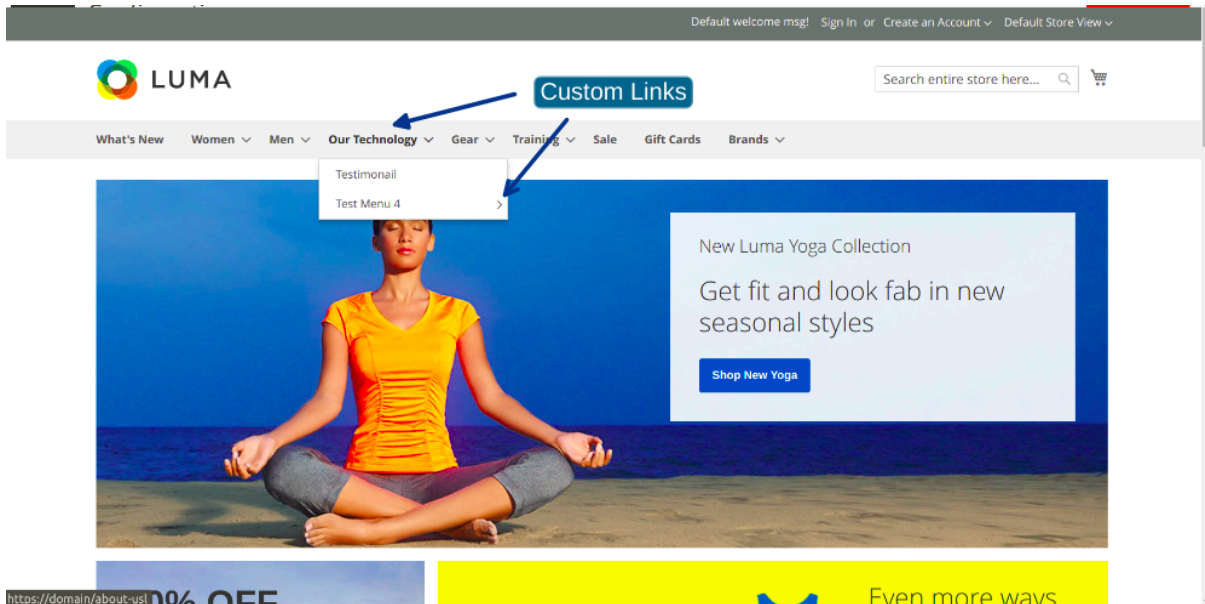
To add a new link to Top menu move to:

Stores -> Configuration -> WebbyTroops -> Advanced Custom Links -> Top Menu Links

OR

WebbyTroops -> Advanced Custom Links -> Top Menu Links

- 3.1. Enable this feature
- 3.2. Add Title
- 3.3. Add URL (This can be only Magento path 'about-us' or complete link 'https://DOMAIN/about-us')
- 3.4. Select Category (Around which the link will be shown)
- 3.5. Select Position (Show the menu before/after/inside the selected category)
- 3.6. Save Config
- 3.7. Cache Flush

Add new link in Top Menu:

1. Add title for the new link.
2. Add url like Magento path (about-us) or complete link (https://DOMAIN/about-us).
3. Select parent around that this menu will be shown.
4. Select the position between before/after/inside.

URL can be entered as only path 'about-us' or complete link 'https://DOMAIN/about-us'.

4. Change Root category for Top Menu

Selected category will be treated as the root category for Top Menu and its sub-categories will be visible in the top menu.


To change the parent category of Top menu move to:

Stores -> Configuration -> WebbyTroops -> Advanced Custom Links -> Manage Top Menu Root Category

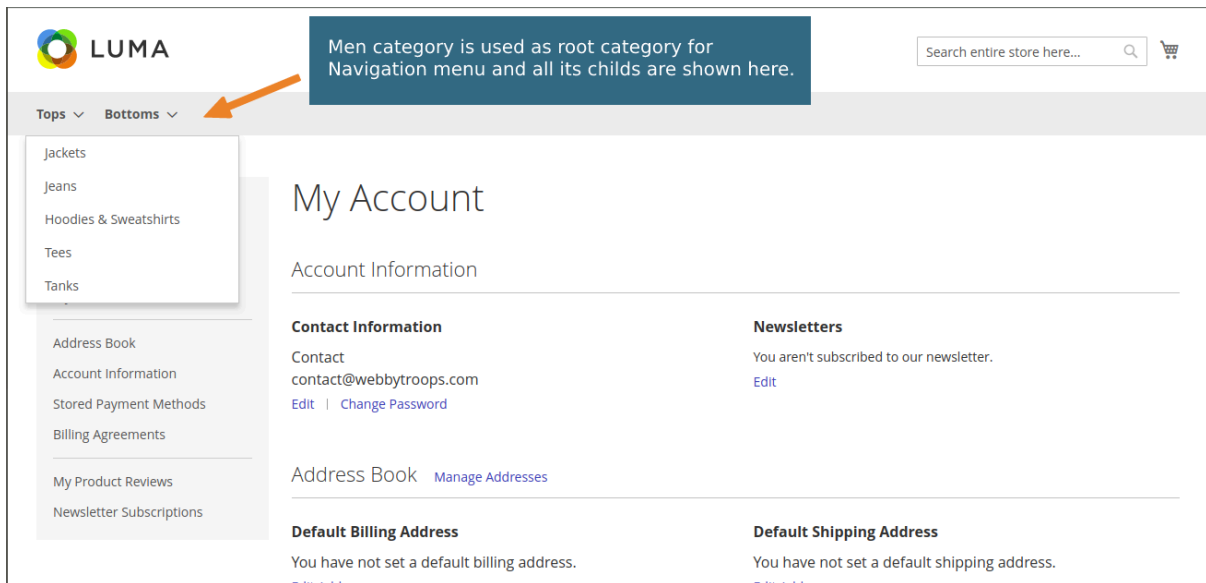

- 4.3. Save Config
- 4.4. Cache Flush

- 5.2. Add Title
- 5.3. Add URL (this can be only Magento path 'about-us' or complete link 'https://DOMAIN/about-us')
- 5.4. Add Position (it should be unique and greater than 0)
- 5.5. Save Config
- 5.6. Cache Flush

Add new link in Customer Sidebar:

1. Add Title for the new link
2. Add its URL e.g. only Magento path (policy) or complete link (http://DOMAIN/policy)
3. Enter position of the new link (unique and greater than 0)

NOTE: To modify title or position of existing link keep the URL same e.g. for My Orders URL will be (sales/order/history)

1. URL can be entered as only path 'about-us' or complete link 'https://DOMAIN/about-us'.
 2. Please keep position unique and greater than 0.
 3. To update label or position of existing links enter the path/link of the existing link and use the new label or position. e.g. to change My Orders label or position use the path 'sales/order/history'.

6. Update label and position of existing links in Customer my account sidebar

Label and position of existing links in the customer my account sidebar can be updated using this.

To update existing links go to:

Stores -> Configuration -> WebbyTroops -> Advanced Custom Links -> Customer Account Sidebar

WebbyTroops -> Advanced Custom Links -> Customer Account Sidebar

- 6.2. Add Title
- 6.3. URL: To change label or position of existing link enter the existing URL e.g. to modify My Orders use 'sales/order/history' in path).
- 6.4. Add Position
- 6.5. Save Config
- 6.6. Cache Flush
