Make My Shipping Rules

Out of box Magento 2 restricts shipping methods for different required rules. What if you wish to add a shipping method for your platform store that allows you the control to add unlimited shipping rules for various conditions and even with Custom Shipping Methods?

Magento 2 Make My Shipping Rules extension is your one stop destination for all your needs to control shipping cost by setting up shipping rules.

1. Introduction and Purpose

By default, Magento 2 does not provide any feature that allows you to add your own shipping method with an unlimited set of shipping rules. This Magento 2 Make My Shipping Rules take the shipping area on the next level with a user-friendly interface and easy to handle options.


The product is the outcome of extensive Market research and has been implemented after analysing reviews by multiple store owners, in order to make it more efficient and compete in the Market.

2. Key features

- Add unlimited shipping rules for your current out of box or custom shipping methods.
- Add shipping rules specific for:
 - Store
 - Customer Group
 - Specific Customers
 - Product Attributes (i.e. product SKUs, weight, price etc)
 - Shopping Cart Rules
 - Country or Region
 - Specific day or period
- Easily set shipping cost on your product.
- Possibility of adding Shipping handling fees as fixed or percentage.
- Lifetime updates for the module at free of cost.


3. How to enable extension?

- 3.1. Once you get the license key (refer to installation guide) you need to navigate to the Make My Shipping Rule section under **Stores > Configuration > WebbyTroops** section. Below is the screenshot where you need to add that license key.



4.1. Add rule for specific customers and customer groups

Click on the Add New Shipping Rule. In new form, select specific customers and customer groups for which rules need to be created.

4.2. Add rule according to product attributes

Expand Condition tab to specify product conditions according to which the rule will be applied in Shipping Cost calculation.

4.3. Add rule according to cart attributes

In the condition tab, new conditions can be set according to shopping cart attributes like subtotal, shipping country, shipping region etc.





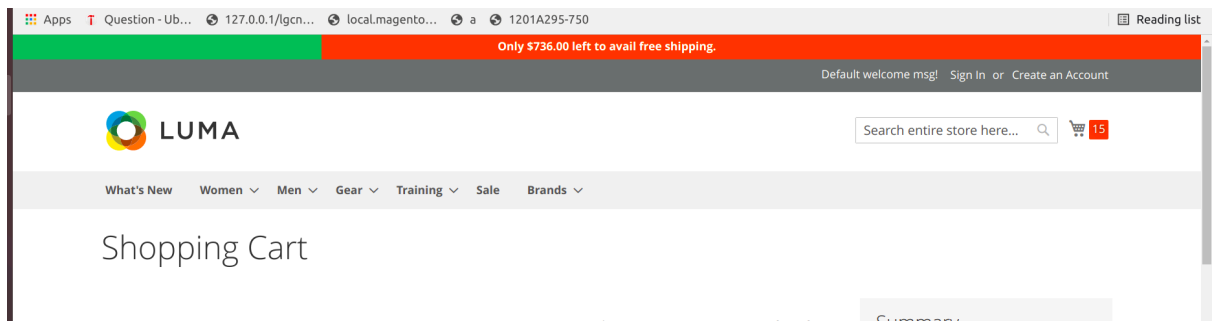
6. Free Shipping Bar Configuration

If you want to use this extension with Free Shipping Bar extension then you need to make the below configuration. When you have the Free Shipping Bar extension installed then you will see the below tab in shipping rule form.



Here you can enable the free shipping and can define the free shipping amount, this amount will be considered as free shipping bar threshold value. After this you need to select the threshold calculation type as WebbyTroops Shipping Rules under Stores -> Configuration -> WebbyTroops -> Free Shipping Bar.

Let's take an example to understand how this rule will work. Let's say admin has added one rule with free shipping amount as 1000 and they have added required conditions. Admin has a requirement to give free shipping if the cart amount is greater than 1000 and customer has to be charged for 20 if the cart amount is less than 1000 So in the shipping rule he will define 20 as shipping cost. Customers can see how far they are from getting a free shipping bar. Once a customer has a cart amount greater than 1000 they will get free shipping and this rule will show shipping price as 0. Below is an example of how bar will be visible in the storefront.
